Orange County Housing Authority (OCHA)

### Mainstream Voucher Program Implementation

In partnership with the Orange County Health Care Agency (HCA), the Orange County Housing Authority has been awarded Mainstream Voucher Program funding to provide rental assistance to non-elderly homeless persons with disabilities.

Beginning in December 2018, OCHA will accept referrals for Mainstream Voucher Program rental assistance from HCA's Whole Person Care (WPC) Program. Additionally, any persons who meet the conditions below may contact the Whole Person Care Program at (714) 834-5891 or OCHA at (714) 480-2747 for evaluation of their eligibility to assistance.

- Between the ages of 18 and 61 Has a disability, as defined in 42 U.S.C. 423
- Is determined, pursuant to US Department of Housing and Urban Development regulations, to have a physical, mental, or emotional impairment that:
  - - Is expected to be of long-continued and indefinite duration;
  - - Substantially impedes his or her ability to live independently, and
  - - Is of such a nature that the ability to live independently could be improved by more suitable housing conditions; or
- Has a developmental disability as defined in 42 U.S.C. 6001
- Receives Medi-Cal from the County of Orange
- Is homeless and is currently or has had an admission to recuperative care
