

The Orange County Housing Authority (OCHA) will begin accepting applications for Project Based Voucher (PBV) units for Veterans and individuals experiencing homelessness on November 02, 2020 until further notice. The project, hereafter known as Salerno at Cypress Village, is located at 501 Nightmist, Irvine, CA 92618, and will have ten (10) three-bedroom units available for individuals experiencing homelessness, and eleven (11) one-bedroom and four (4) three-bedroom units available for eligible Veterans.

Individuals who are experiencing homelessness, on OCHA's current Housing Choice Voucher waiting list, and interested in applying for Salerno at Cypress Village may dial 2-1-1 to be connected to an Orange County Coordinated Entry System (CES) access point for households experiencing homelessness. 2-1-1 staff will connect you to the provider appropriate to your circumstances for connection to CES. For the units identified for individuals experiencing homelessness, admission preference will be given to applicants experiencing homelessness and referred by the CES to OCHA. CES will verify homeless preference eligibility prior to referral to OCHA.

Interested Veterans must meet the Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing (HUD-VASH) eligibility criteria, which includes, but is not limited to, VA health care eligibility and experiencing homelessness, as defined in the McKinney Homeless Assistance Act. Interested Veterans may contact the VA Community Resource & Referral Center (CCRC) for a determination of eligibility at 844-838-8300.

For the units identified for Veterans experiencing homelessness, eligible individuals (as stated in preceding paragraph) who CES refers to OCHA will be given an admission preference.
